Subject objectives

Subject outcomes

Within the program of this course, the student will be able to: understand the structure of the national company legislation, as well as the structure of international standards in this area (referring to the directives of the EU), develop the capability of analytical approaches to legal problems as well as to offer doctrinal and analytical answers within the questions of the founding of economic societies, legislative characters, the protection of minority shareholders, and the other questions, develop the capabilities necessary for competent and argumentative discussions, research and present the results of his scientific work and to apply the knowledge through work in the company.
